#### AZAD ACADEMY

With a view to provide education for children in the age group of 4-14 years, village learning centers have been setup at two villages. They have been named "Azad Academy" after the deity in the villages. Promising children from such schools are coopted into the full time School. Currently there two "Azad Academy" operational – at Khanpur, and Jadupur villages of Chanchal-II block. The total enrolment is about four hundred students in there three centers. Education provided is based on the syllabus of West Bengal Primary Board in modern education.

The objective is to supplement over the inadequacies of marginalized students in learning the subjects of school curriculum, so that there is no drop-out once they join middle/high school. Such programme is run in remote and backward areas, where students are first generation learners and get no support from their parents during home study.

The schools which started from 2005 have played a pivotal role in bringing about a noticeable change in the lives of the children and through them their families as well. Students enjoy coming to school-to study, play and learn and celebrate special days of national importance apart from having annual sports. Good support and cooperation is provided by the parents who are indebted to KAGUS for creating an ideal atmosphere for grooming and upbringing of their child/children.



#### **KAGUS HEALTH HOME**

The KAGUS provides primary health care service to the rural and semi urban population in Khanpur and also nearby areas through the KAGUS Charitable Dispensary and equipped with the doctors, paramedical and medicine. In others places camps are held in different area of Chanchal-II block. The quality treatment services rendered with sincerity and affection by the KAGUS Health Home build the trust of the villagers on scientific means of treatment. Apart from these KAGUS has frequently conducted Mobile Clinic Health Checkup Camps in the villages to identify the people with concerned health issues so as to provide the further assistance for the treatment and medication to ensure the health of the community.



It has also organized a Clinic Programme on Homeopathy is KAGUS campus. Different health related issues were discussed in these programmes including immunization, institutional delivery. KAGUS also organized free health checkup camps for villagers.

#### RAJIV GANDHI NATIONAL CRECHE SCHEME

KAGUS has been four Chrche Center since 2006-07 for Children of age 6 month to 6 years, of working women in both rural & urban areas who are employed. Every Centre has two nos. Crèche mothers and 25 nos. of 1-5 year aged children. The crèches run from 9.00 a.m. to 4.30 p.m. The Crèche Programme is a day-care programme

provided some nutritional food for children of working or sick mothers from poor families who can go to work knowing that their children are safe and well cared for. The Centers have adequate facilities of utensils to feed the children and which should be cleaned regularly before and after use and boxes must be available and safely placed.

Regular and strict monitoring of the centers conducted at different levels to ensure effective running of the scheme and also to ensure that the beneficiaries are delivered services as envisaged in the scheme.



#### **MEDICAL CAMP**

Access to health care and equitable distribution of health services are the fundamental requirements for achieving the Millennium Development Goals. And with that view the government has launched the Mobile Medical Unit under NHM in some selected blocks in October, 2011. Taking health care to the doorsteps is the principle behind this initiative and intended to reach underserved

areas. KAGUS has been entrusted by West Bengal Health and Family Welfare Samity and NHM in Chanchal-II block of Malda district of West Bengal. More than before and much stronger linkages were built with government health officials and NRHM, which has further augmented the project's reach to the underprivileged people and promotion of overall health seeking behavior by contributing clinical services. During this period KAGUS has organized 16 health camps in the outreach areas.

The health camps ware organized as per the need of the community in the inaccessible areas with the support of the Health Depts. Officials. Local MLAs, PRI representatives & other dignitaries remain present in those camps to encourage the local peoples including targeted population of the Community to participate in those camps. General Medical check-up done in those camps.

#### **ROGI SAHAYATA KENDRA**

KAGUS started operating the Rogi Sahayata Kendra of Amarkanan Rural Hospital from 17<sup>th</sup> December 2015.

#### Responsibilities of the Rogi Sahayaks Kendra

- Provide information sought for by the visitors in a friendly manner.
- Provide guidance to the visitors/ patients.
- Maintain and update information database.
- Receive complaints/grievances/ suggestions, record them in appropriate registers, issue a receipt, and forward the complaints/ grievances/ suggestions to the superintendent of the end of each shift.
- Maintain and update list of high-risk/serious patients.
- Take other necessary steps to ensure optimum functioning of Rogi Sahayata Kendra.
- Maintaining the checklist for Doctor-party meet.
- Provide knowledge on different NRHM schemes to the mothers on JSSK.
- Statutory announcement from time to time in Public Address System.
- RSBY registration, Reception and processing.

#### SHPI (SHGS), JLGS & FARMERS CLUB- Formation & Mobilization

KAGUS thinks that it can change the status of the deplorable condition of the women, Poor people and farmers' folk only by the kind help and support of the Govt, and by the well-wishers by supplying the above mentioned necessary facilities to those backward areas. KAGUS working as SHPI since 2008-09 for SHGs, JLGs and Farmers Clubs formation in the Malda District and monitoring by Identify poor men and women. Then they have get train on Capacity building, Books maintenance, Bank linkage, Social activities, Guidance in economic activities, Plan for withdrawal and this year these groups members are mostly self-confidence on their income while there were engaged various programme of our EDPs and skill development training. A Joint Liability Group (JLG) is an informal group comprising of 4-10 individuals coming together for the purpose of availing bank loan on individual basis or through group mechanism against mutual guarantee. Generally, the members of a JLG would engage in a similar type of economic activity in the Agriculture / Allied / Non-Farm Sector.

The members would offer a joint undertaking to the bank that enables them to avail loans. JLG members are expected to provide support to each other in carrying out occupational and social activities. Through this scheme with the collaboration of NABARD the organization formed 160 nos. and in this regard 1960 families have been benefited through bank credit linkage various bank District Malda. They made 150 SHGs and give them various types of vocational

Trainings for their income generation. They also arrange some awareness camp in the Schools with the students and the teachers and GPs and blocks with the Govt. service providers.

#### **DRINKING WATER**

KAGUS has been working to afford safe drinking water to the rural population over the years. KAGUS has successfully implemented 800 community safe drinking water projects in with the support of Al-Hedaya Charity Association, Kuwait and Kuwait Embassy. The project aspires to: increase the access of potable water to the community; prevent contamination of water sources; behavioral change amongst people concerning water utilization. Under the Water Security Project, to improve access to potable water, various interventions



These tube wells provide drinking water for the people of these areas. This led to reduction in common ailments mainly water borne diseases. This also triggered a change in behavior of health and hygiene. In many areas the risks of water borne diseases continue after the initial floods, increasing the likelihood of water contamination and the development of epidemic diseases.

#### **VOCATIONAL TRAINING**

KAGUS started has been working to improve the livelihood conditions of the poor people of the area through the SHGs. It has taken up several incomes generation initiatives to ensure that the members of the SHGs become self-reliant and earn additional income to support their families. KAGUS has primarily channelized the fund from its own coffers and with contribution from beneficiaries. This programme is for unemployed Youth Women Group. This year 25 SHGs group are trained in different kind of training.



The main focus of rural development is to provide the better environment to a child in terms of the basic need of children – food, shelter, treatment, education and poverty less happy family. The main hindrance of rural area is poverty and lack of entrepreneurship. The organization's main focus is to promote the socio-economic development by way of development. KAGUS always emphasizes to develop the skills and capacity of the worker through training, workshop and exposures. As skill up gradation trainings alone have limited impact on livelihood creation among the SHG members, it was thought prudent to create sustainable livelihoods among SHG members.

#### **RNTCP**

KAGUS demonstrated that access to RNTCP services could be increased for private patients and that it was possible to engage PPs in TB control efforts. More than 2000 PPs were sensitized through workshops and one-to-one visits. KAGUS improve the visibility and effectiveness of RNTCP in 3 Hospitals, which covers about 22 Gram Panchayet. KAGUS is making use of provision of RNTCP effectively. Rural Health Care Providers, who cater health needs of major rural population, have recognized and encouraged to play a role of DOTS provider under RNTCP for the effective TB control. KAGUS aims to increase the public awareness on TB control and features of RNTCP through pharmacists; to encourage pharmacists for the referrals of symptomatic cases approaching them for timely diagnosis.

#### **SWACH BHARAT MISSION**

Open defecation, especially, is a major issue and it poses great threat to hygienic living conditions. Flies sit on excreta and carry germs when they sit on food. During rainy season the excreta is washed into ponds and wells thus contaminating them. Public places with improper sanitation facilities results in increased cases of diarrhea and typhoid. Clearly, the need for proper and hygienic toilet facilities cannot be denied. Therefore keeping our objective of promoting "Total Sanitation" and following an integrated approach, our programs focus on building safe sanitation systems and simultaneously also creating awareness for the good hygiene practices. One of the other initiatives taken by KAGUS in order to link health and sanitation under Swachh Bharat Mission. In the Chanchal-II blocks of Chandrapara GP, 41 household were constructed the latrine. Moreover the villagers have developed a healthy habit of not using the open space for defecation and use the latrines. Privacy and safety of women has increased and they are happy to have this asset in their homes.

#### **FOOD DISTRIBUTION**

Food is a basic necessity and having access to it is a right. Imagine going without food for a day. It's almost impossible for us to survive a single day without food and yet, there are so many children who starve for days. We don't just provide food; we provide nutritious food that takes care of their overall well-being. It fills our hearts with joy every time we feed a poor. This year KAGUS have distributed the food kit in 10 places and which covers 2000 beneficiary covered. This project is covers under Sadaka Tasi Derneg Turkey. We primarily focus on the widow women and extremely poor families have been involved in the transforming their lives, while ensuring a better future for them.



#### SABALA MELA

Sabala in a comprehensive programme on Adolescents centrally sponsored program of Government of India initiated under Ministry of Women and Child Development. KAGUS got the opportunity to participate in the Sabala Mela held at Chanchal Siddheswari Institution (CSI), Chanchanchal, Malda. Various posters and other IEC materials

were used for the awareness generation on the issue on child and adolescents. Free counseling was provided on exclusive breast feeding, child nutrition, health and hygiene during adolescence etc.
